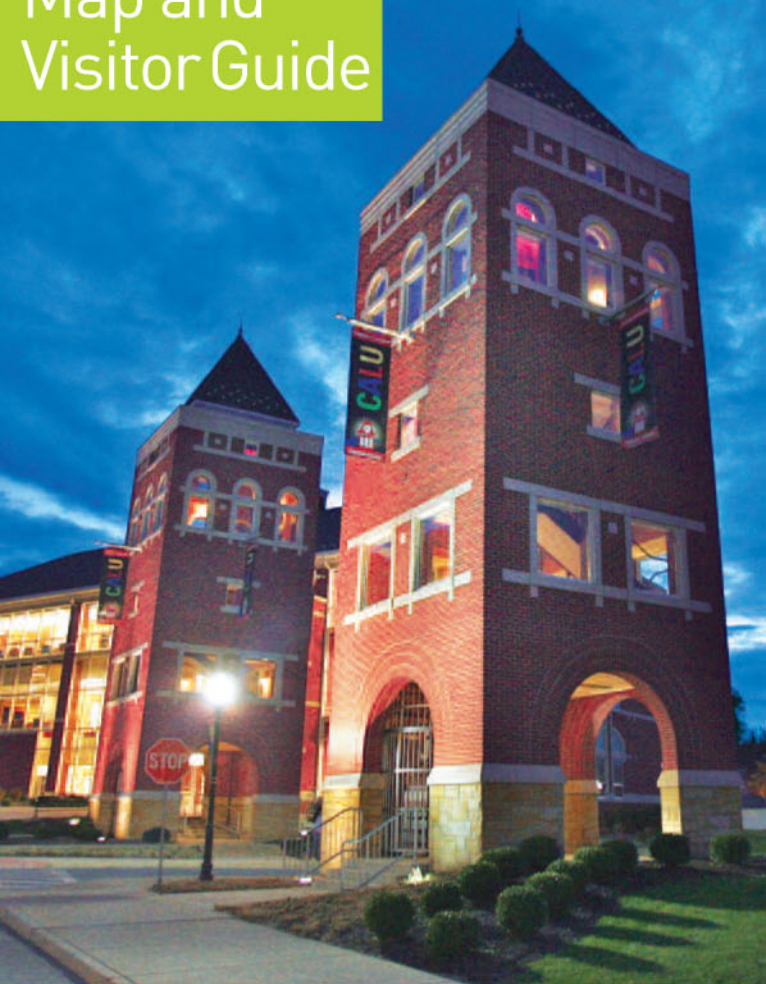


Campus Map and Visitor Guide

Then and now

California University of Pennsylvania is steeped in history. Founded in 1852 as California Academy, it has transformed itself many times — first as a normal school, then as a state teachers college, and again as a state college before becoming a University in 1983. The campus has grown as well, from a handful of buildings in

Cal U's early days to the 40 that stand today. While the stately older structures reflect the University's roots, the many new classroom buildings and residence halls demonstrate the University's commitment to **technology and innovation**.

Today, Cal U is a proud member of the Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education, offering more than 150 undergraduate courses of study and 50 graduate programs, as well as associate degrees and certificate programs. The University has been nationally recognized for **academic excellence**, and for its emphasis on building character as well as careers.



Located just 35 miles from downtown Pittsburgh, Cal U provides a wealth of opportunities for students. **Outdoor enthusiasts** can enjoy hiking, biking, rafting, skiing and horseback riding nearby. Major retail stores are just minutes away — and so are numerous antique shops and specialty stores. The city of Pittsburgh not only offers diverse cultural experiences, major league sporting events and lively restaurants, but also a vital connection to internships and a dynamic business community.

FROM THE EAST (Harrisburg, Philadelphia)
PA Turnpike to New Stanton, Exit 75. Interstate 70 West to Exit 37A (Toll Road 43).

FROM THE NORTHEAST (Scranton)
Interstate 81 South to PA Turnpike. PA Turnpike West to New Stanton, Exit 75. Interstate 70 West to Exit 37A (Toll Road 43).

FROM THE NORTH (Erie, Pittsburgh)
Interstate 79 South to Interstate 70 Exit. Interstate 70 East to Exit 37A (Toll Road 43).

FROM THE SOUTHEAST (Baltimore, Washington DC)
Interstate 70 West to PA Turnpike West to New Stanton, Exit 75. Interstate 70 West to Exit 37A (Toll Road 43).

FROM THE WEST, SOUTHWEST (Ohio, West Virginia)
Interstate 70 East to Exit 37A (Toll Road 43).

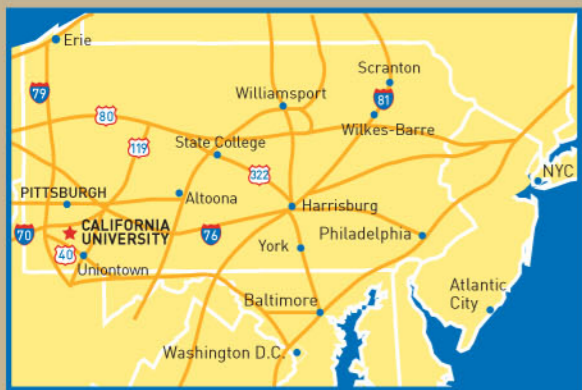
FROM TOLL ROAD 43
Take the California exit (bear right at end of exit). Stay straight toward Wood Street. Follow Wood Street down to intersection at Third Street. At the stop light, turn right onto Third Street and follow straight onto campus.

Parking is available in the Vulcan Garage; turn right just before the campus entrance.
